This form is designed as an aid for centres making entries via the Cambridge Assessment Admissions Testing Entries Extranet. It will NOT be accepted as an entry by Cambridge Assessment Admissions Testing.

Entries must be made by centres between 01 September and 29 September 2023 6:00 PM (BTS = UTC+1).

IMPORTANT! The above deadline is for the test centre to submit registrations on the central registration system. The test centre can only submit a registration if we received all documents (registration form, payment and payment proof). Please note that bank transfers might need 1-2 working days to arrive into our bank account (for domestic transfers, for international transfers that could even take longer) so make sure that your application arrives in full well in time.

This registration form should NOT be returned to Cambridge Assessment Admissions Testing but should be handed to your test centre. All entries must be made by registered centres via the Cambridge Assessment Admissions Testing Entries Extranet.

BMAT - Please note, applicants must only take BMAT once in an admissions cycle.
